Glass design is probably one of those primary crafts that has triggered human creativity, expanding its spirit, its knowledge, and other things as well.

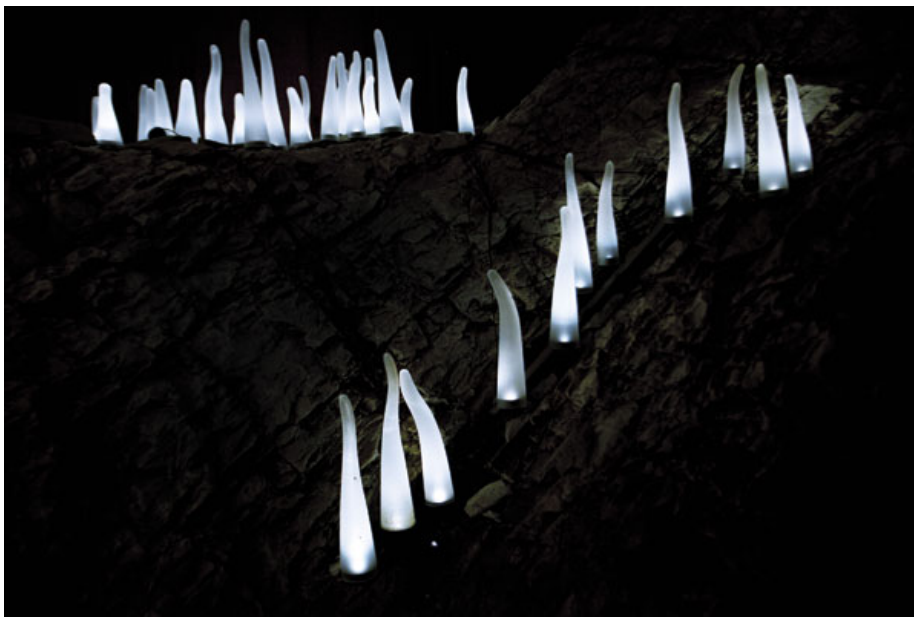
